 - (b) 'P' makes an application for regular bail in the court of session. The application is rejected. Now he wants to make a fresh application for anticipatory bail u/s. 438 Cr.P.C. in the High Court. Advise him.
 - (c) 'A' a Marathi speaking accused is tried at Belgaum Court. All witnesses deposed in Kannada. 'A' wants the same to be interpreted to him in Marathi. the Court rejects his prayer. Decide.
